NONRESIDENT TUITION

Education Code Sections 68050, 68051, 68130, 68130.5, 76140, and 76141; Title 5 Section 54045.5

Nonresident students are those students who have not established residence in California for one year and a day as of the residence determination date published in the college catalog and those who are not eligible to establish residency (e.g. international students under certain visas).

Nonresident students shall be charged nonresident tuition for all units enrolled in accordance with Education Code Section 76140. The Superintendent/President shall establish procedures regarding collection, exemptions, and refunds of nonresident tuition.

In addition, the District applies a capital outlay fee (for capital outlay, maintenance, and equipment) and any applicable waivers to nonresidents in accordance with Education Code Section 76141.

By March 1 of each year, the Superintendent/President shall bring to the Board of Trustees for approval an action to establish nonresident tuition and the capital outlay fee for the following academic year.
